# How can animals move?

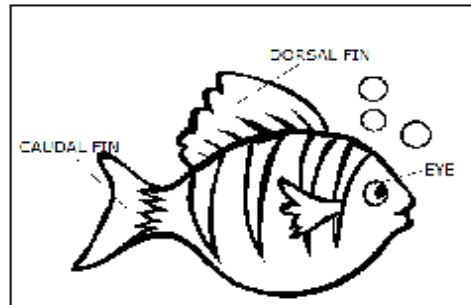


Kangaroos can jump because they have strong legs.

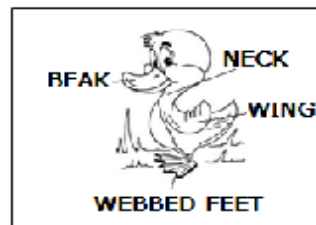
## How can ANIMALs move?

Fish can swim because they have fins.

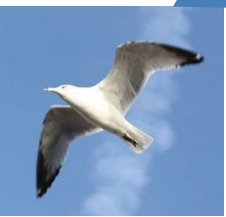


Ducks can swim because they have webbed feet.
